Absences: If your child is sick or has an appointment, please send a note or email so that the absence can be coded correctly.

Book Orders: I send home Scholastic Book Orders about once each month. This is a wonderful way to build your child's home library and help our class at the same time. Our class earns Bonus Points with each order that I can use to buy books and materials for our classroom.

Box Tops: An easy way to help our school is by collecting Box Tops for Education. They are found on many foods and the school earns 10 cents for every box top submitted.

Connect Classes: Students will participate in Connect classes on a 6-day rotation for Art, Spanish, PE, Studio, Music, Action Based Learning Lab, Media and STEAM. Wednesday and Thursday are double connect days.
